Language and Speech: to develop the ability to talk and express needs using:

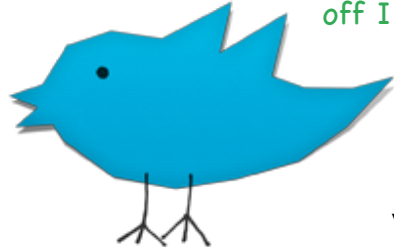
1. Music and Instruments

2019 - 2020 PROGRAMS

Students must be of age for class by September 1st of the school year.

SHEEP CLASS (4 AND 5 YEARS OLDS) M, W, F

The objective of the 4/5 year old class is to provide a loving, safe, structured educational environment. The children learn basic developments and standards to help prepare children for kindergarten. Class is from 9 - 11:30 am and monthly tuition of \$130

LAMB CLASS (3 YEARS OLDS) T, R

The objective the 3 year old class is to provide a loving, safe environment with fellow peers. The children learn to share and communicate with their peers using their words. Have multiple units and classroom structure. Class is from 9 - 11:30 am and monthly tuition of \$110

LITTLEST LAMB (2 YEARS OLDS) T, R

The objective of the 2 year old class is to provide a loving, comfortable, environment to ease the separation from home to school. The children learn to trust in this atmosphere, allowing them to learn and make new friends. Class is from 9:15 - 11:15 am and monthly tuition of \$110

How to Register

To be enrolled in the class, a completed application form and \$30.00 NON REFUNDABLE Registration fee must be received. A confirmation of your child's enrollment will be mailed. Application will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis. Non-refundable first month tuition is due July 1st. If this is not paid, enrollment is terminated. * Registration Fee increases to \$40 after June 1st, 2019.
